## FACEBOOK POSTS

We want to help you get more supporters at your clubs when there is a game on at the stadium next door. We've created a really simple slide that you can write info on and post on your facebook the night before a game encouraging people to come down for a drink.

You might want to advertise the price of your parking, the fact you're a fully licensed bar and what time you open before a game – but knowing that these things can change, we've left it blank for you to fill in. You can do this on Powerpoint, then use "save as" to save a jpeg that can be uploaded to Facebook.

The next slide shows an example for guidance.



## **EXAMPLE POST**

The slide can be used to convey whatever match day message you want, but to keep it easily readable you should keep the writing to the left hand side of the page.

This is a local post for your local club, so make sure you're talking about derbies, big games and show your support for the local club.





## WIDER SOCIAL MEDIA
